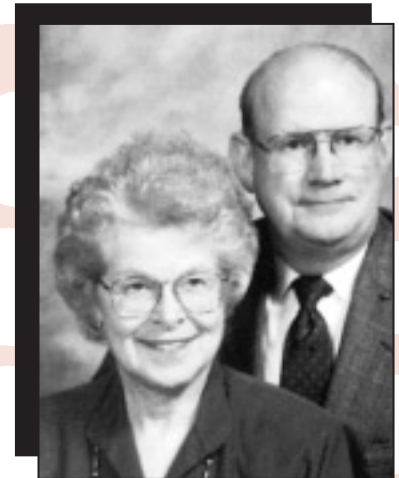
Dr. Reuben and Marloe Bareis came to Rapid City in 1957 where Reuben practiced Internal Medicine and Geriatrics and his wife worked as a Registered Nurse. While raising their four children in Rapid City, Reuben and Marloe dedicated their professional lives to providing chronic health care to the elderly throughout the region. Dr. Bareis has even chronicled the evolution of the health care profession in the Black Hills in a book entitled *Compassionate Caregivers A Memoir: Unsung Heroes Serving the Twilight Years of Life*.

To the Bareis family, giving is a way of life, so when the Bareises and their partner prepared to sell their medical building, Reuben and Marloe looked to the South Dakota Community Foundation to help them continue their role as compassionate caregivers.

By transferring their interest in the medical building, the Bareises avoided tax consequences on the gain in the value of the property and are entitled to a charitable deduction for their generous gift. After making some immediate distributions to several charities and nonprofit entities, the Bareises started a permanent endowment fund with the South Dakota Community Foundation to benefit their favorite charities forever.

In his book, Dr. Bareis describes his and his wife's

efforts by saying, "In any human endeavor one weighs the pleasure of accomplishment against the stress of hard work." Dr. and Mrs. Bareis indeed accomplished many things in their life time with great effort, and through their generous gift, many others will be able to accomplish great things as well. Their commitment to giving and providing care for others will continue forever.

## New Funds Established

Eleven new permanently endowed funds were established in the second half of 2003. The assets from these new funds total almost \$600,000 and top off a list of 220 funds totaling \$35 million in permanent assets. We welcome our new partners and look forward to providing dollars on an ongoing basis to improve the lives of South Dakotans.

### **Bob & Lori Sutton Family Fund:**

A Donor Advised Fund established to provide financial support to charitable and non-profit entities at the donors' recommendations.

### **Brian Meyer Memorial Scholarship Fund:**

A Scholarship Fund to provide educational assistance to students pursuing post-secondary degrees at accredited South Dakota institutions. Scholarship awards are overseen by the South Dakota Association of Telephone Cooperatives.

### **Emily & Robert Entwisle Family Fund:**

Donor Designated Fund started by Robert and Emily to provide financial support to non-profits and charities as named by the donors. This fund will be the ultimate beneficiary of a charitable remainder trust established by the donors.

### **Hoch Drug Foundation:**

This Donor Advised Fund established by the Hoch family will be used to support non-profit and charitable entities at the donors' recommendations.

### **Milton & Leona Lindell Scholarship Fund:**

Initiated by Mr. and Mrs. Lindell, this Scholarship Fund will provide financial scholarships for Veblen area students graduating

from any high school and approved by the local committee to attend any college, university or accredited vocational school.

### **Rasmussen Family Fund:**

A Donor Advised fund established by the family to support non-profit and charitable causes in the Wessington Springs community.

### **Reuben & Marloe Bareis Family Fund:**

A Donor Advised Fund established by the Dr. Reuben and Marloe Bareis to benefit non-profit and charitable causes at the recommendations of the donors.

### **Richard Joy Fund:**

Established by Mr. Joy, this Donor Advised Fund will be used to provide financial support to charities and non-profits at the donor's recommendation.

### **Robert Disburg Memorial Scholarship Fund:**

This permanent endowment fund was started in loving memory of Robert Disburg by his family and will provide scholarship support to players from the American Legion Post 8 baseball team.

### **SDATC Memorial Scholarship Fund:**

This fund will be used to provide financial scholarships to students attending technical schools pursuing a career in the field of telecommunications. The scholarship awards are overseen by the South Dakota Association of Telephone Cooperatives.

### **South Dakota Humanities Council Foundation Fund:**

A permanent endowment fund to provide ongoing financial support to the South Dakota Humanities Council programming.

## SDCF BOARD OF DIRECTORS WELCOMES THREE NEW MEMBERS

The Board of Directors of the SDCF held its annual election of board members at a semi-annual meeting in Pierre on October 28, 2003. Three new members were unanimously elected at that meeting to serve a three-year term.

Barry Grossenburg is a third generation John Deere dealer from Winner, South Dakota, and has been involved in the family business since he was ten years old. Barry is now the sole owner of Grossenburg Implement. Barry has been involved with the First Fidelity Tripp County Area Foundation for several years and was influential in establishing the Mellette County Area Foundation. He recognizes and values the premise behind "community savings accounts" providing funds for South Dakota's communities forever. Barry has also dedicated many years to the Boy Scouts. He is an Eagle Scout, a recipient of the Silver Beaver Award and helped his son obtain his Eagle Scout as well. We look forward to Barry's enthusiasm and ideas as he joins the Resource Development/Planned Giving Committee of the Board.

Thomas Sannes is a native of Webster, South Dakota, and currently practices law with Delaney, Vander Linden & Delaney. Before returning to Webster, he was a Captain in the United States Judge Advocate General Corps. Tom is the President of the Day County Community Foundation and helped them obtain a \$25,000 challenge grant from the SDCF. He is also a Commander of the Webster American Legion Post #40, a volunteer Boy Scout leader, and is an Eagle Scout. He is part of the Masons, and a member of the Sisseton VFW Post. Tom will also be joining our Resource Development/Planned Giving Committee, and we look forward to his insight and energy.

Ann Sigleman is a long time resident of Watertown, South Dakota, where she and her late husband Paul, owned and operated an auto supply store. Ann currently serves on the Watertown Community Foundation board and the Watertown Art Festival Board. She runs a small "bead" company from her home and is involved in a family owned real estate company, PANN Holdings LLC. Ann has also served on the Board of Prairie Lakes Hospital and was one of the first co-chairs of the hospital foundation fund raiser call BASH. Ann also served as a hospice volunteer for several years before her husband's death. Ann will be putting her board service experience to good use by joining the Foundation's Board Development Committee.

These three individuals join nineteen other outstanding South Dakotans currently serving on the SDCF's Board of Directors. We welcome them and look forward to putting their many talents to use in expanding our vision for South Dakota.

# Grants Awarded



The SDCF Board of Directors awarded seventeen grants in the second half of 2003, totaling nearly \$175,000. We received forty-one applications requesting almost \$1 million in funding.

**Association for Enterprise Opportunity, Arlington, VA - \$5,000**  
Funds to assist in establishing a small business and microenterprise development training site in South Dakota. The Regional Microenterprise Development Training Institutes are aimed at strengthening area organizations and helping them achieve increased program outcomes (business starts and loans) leading to greater community economic impact.

**Badlands South Central Enterprise Facilitation, White River, SD - \$4,000**  
An Economic Development grant to assist in providing business planning assistance to small business operators and aspiring entrepreneurs in a nine county region in western South Dakota.

**Black Hills Community Economic Development, Inc., Sturgis, SD - \$15,000**  
This grant will provide financial assistance for developing and implementing a marketing plan for the 114-mile George S. Mickelson Trail. The Mickelson Trail is visited annually by approximately 10,000 people.

**Cheyenne River Youth Project, Eagle Butte, SD - \$20,000**  
A Human Services grant was awarded to help with their facility and program expansion. The funds will enable Cheyenne River Youth Project to serve the needs of 13-17 year olds, in addition to the 5-12 year old children they have served since 1988. The program provides meals, recreational and educational opportunities, and countless other services, such as counseling to over 300 different children per month. The grant is contingent on raising an additional \$750,000 to complete the project.

**Dupree Daycare, Inc., Dupree, SD - \$5,000**  
This grant was awarded to help with the costs of acquiring a Governor's Daycare facility and to expand the existing childcare program to include preschool services for twenty children on a daily basis.

**Ipswich Commercial Club, Ipswich, SD - \$10,000**  
A grant to assist in purchasing property and constructing permanent facilities that will accommodate a number of community activities.

**Mammoth Site of Hot Springs, SD Inc., Hot Springs, SD - \$15,000**  
Matching funds grant to construct a

ninety-eight seat capacity theatre/lecture hall. The new addition will also accommodate additional exhibits and storage. The grant is contingent on raising an additional \$775,000 to complete the project.

**Northeast South Dakota Community Action Program, Sisseton, SD - \$10,000**  
A matching funds grant that assists low income people in making a down payment on a home through a Certificate of Deposit Pledge program. The grant was contingent on a \$30,000 commitment from NESDCAP.

**Pierre Indian Learning Center, Pierre, SD - \$1,000**  
Financial assistance to support the Healing of Nations Conference on racial reconciliation that was held in Pierre. The conference provided a forum for discussion on race relations in the state and received support from Governor Rounds and Senator Daschle.

**South Dakota 4-H Foundation, Brookings, SD - \$7,500**  
This Educational grant will assist with a Native American Culture/Character Education program entitled We Are All Relatives. The program brings together character education and traditional Native American culture and is modeled after the widely successful Character Counts program.

**South Dakota Discovery Center & Aquarium, Pierre, SD - \$3,500**  
Funds to assist with the "Science That Leaves No Child Behind" program aimed at providing hands-on science outreach opportunities to 28 South Dakota counties. The grant is contingent on raising \$46,500 in funds for the program.

**South Dakota Humanities Council, Brookings, SD - \$5,000**  
A Cultural Grant to the Center for the Book, an affiliate program of the South Dakota Humanities Council to promote reading in South Dakota. The grant funds will assist with two programs in conjunction with the first annual South Dakota Book Festival in Deadwood, South Dakota.

**South Dakota Rural Enterprise, Inc., Sioux Falls, SD - \$20,000**  
Funds to assist in providing a leveraging pool for economic development loans in communities in South Dakota. The program allows communities to leverage ini-

tial deposits into economic development loans that may be up to ten times the amount of the initial deposit. The grant is contingent on SDREI committing \$60,000 to the program.

**South Eastern Development Foundation, Sioux Falls, SD - \$20,000**  
An Economic Development grant to establish a \$1 million revolving loan fund. The grant will help leverage a \$500,000 Intermediary Re-lending Program loan from USDA. The South Eastern Development Foundation focuses on improving the quality of life in Minnehaha, Turner, Lincoln, Union, Clay and McCook counties.

**Tots-N-Toddlers Daycare and Preschool, Hot Springs, SD - \$3,500**  
Grant assistance to remodel and expand their current facility. The grant money will be used for a four room expansion of the existing facility and other work necessary to meet health and safety standards. The additional space will accommodate the preschoolers at the center and will allow TNT to increase infant/toddler enrollment by 50-100%. The award was contingent on them raising an additional \$13,500 which they successfully completed.

**Wessington Springs Area Development Corporation, Wessington Springs, SD - \$5,000**  
An Economic Development grant to assist with the costs associated with a recently acquired Governor's Daycare facility. The award was contingent on raising an additional \$10,000 which has successfully been completed.

**Yankton Area Progressive Growth, Yankton, SD - \$25,000**  
An Economic Development grant to assist with their "Jobs & Investment for the New Millennium," campaign, a five year campaign to enhance economic development in the Yankton area. YAPG, Inc. serves as the primary partner in the packaging of industrial real estate and incentive financing for Yankton's Economic Development program.
